GLEANING PROGRAM TERMS

1. **Sponsor.** Client is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to cultivate a thriving and sustainable food and agricultural system that improves human health, promotes environmental stewardship, supports a local economy, and encourages a preference for locally produced food.
2. **Gleaning Program.** Client's gleaning program is a charitable community food-gleaning program intended to advance this mission by facilitating provision of donated food to schools and nonprofit community organizations serving individuals with little or no access to healthy food.
3. **Recipient of Gleaned Produce.** Client will donate the gleaned produce to schools and other community organizations. Client will never sell the gleaned produce.
4. **Ownership.** Farmer is either the legal owner of the produce to be gleaned and the land on which it is located or authorized to allow the produce to be taken from the farm identified on the first page of this document (the "Farm").
5. **Permission to Enter.** Farmer expressly invites and grants to Client and its volunteers permission to enter the Farm and to glean any items specified on the first page of this document during the time period specified in this document. Farmer may at any time revoke this permission by giving notice to Client.
6. **Donation by Farmer.** Farmer is making a donation of the gleaned produce and will receive no payment or other consideration for the produce or for permitting the gleaning activity on the Farm.
7. **Participants.** Client involves students and volunteers for gleaning activities. Volunteers for the Program are not employees of Client. Client will obtain liability waivers intended to cover the farmer from each student and volunteer before he or she visits the Farm.
8. **Produce and Land.** Farmer has no reason to believe that the gleaned produce is unfit for human consumption. Farmer will notify Client of any dangerous conditions on Farm property, including any pets or wild animals known to live on the property.
9. **Schedule Changes.** Client may need to cancel or postpone a scheduled gleaning event because of weather or other circumstance. Client will so advise Farmer.
